
Years later, Ryder & Carter are married with 2 children. Ryder has to travel back to make sure the events get them together in the first place. She does and everything will be okay now.

Harlow doesn't come home after a work event, which has Larissa wondering who she spent the night with.




Harlow begins to look for an apartment, which will be much closer to her office than it is to Larissa, which has Larissa worried they might grow apart.
